

**Celebrating “First World Engineering Day for Sustainable Development”, 4th March, 2020

Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) being the statutory regulator body, is representing Pakistan at the apex international professional forums including International Engineering Alliance/Washington Accord and IPEA, NABEEA (Asia), FEIAP (the Asia Pacific) and FEIIC at the Islamic countries/OIC level. PEC has been actively participating and contributing to all the relevant professional forums so that our graduates could be provided with enhanced opportunities for cross border mobility and thus better serve the country.

UNESCO has approved the proposal of World Federation of Engineering Organizations (WFEO) to declare 4th March as “World Engineering Day for Sustainable Development” at the General Conference in November 2019 held at Paris. The first World Engineering Day will be celebrated on 4th March 2020 by all member engineering organizations. The President WFEO, Dr. Marlene Kanga has invited member organizations to promote World Engineering Day and organize celebrations on this day towards sustainable development of the society.

In this regard, the first “World Engineering Day for Sustainable Development” activity will be conducted at the University of Engineering and Technology (UET), Lahore, focusing UN Sustainable Development Goals (SGDs), the Washington Accord/IEA Graduate Attributes (GAs) and Emerging Technologies. Eminent engineers from Academia and Industry will be invited to deliver talk and sharing of ideas to strengthen Engineering profession and collaboration.

The event agenda is as under:

1. Talk by eminent engineers/professionals on the main theme and related topics
2. Awarding certificates and cash awards to best Final Year Design Projects (FYDP) and accepted Research papers submitted by students. PEC gone through a peer review assessment process by a team of expert /jury and chosen best groups for this award.
3. Distribution of Student Registration card by Engr. Jawed Salim Qureshi (Chairman PEC).
